The beginning of Lent is 'L'

which stands for 'learning' and 'love'.

During Lent we focus our life of discipleship by learning more about the love of Christ -- a love which went as far as a cross ... and beyond.

The beginning of Lent is in ashes, referring of course to Ash Wednesday.

> Ashes suggest sorrow and penitence: sorrow for failing God and not following in Christ's way; and the desire to repent from our sins and, with God's help, do better the next time ... and the next, and the next.

And, remembering the love of Christ, those same ashes also suggest forgiveness and renewal: forgiveness through a cross; renewal through resurrection.
