# **Message from Pastor Bill Vincent**


Isaiah 9:2,6

## The CROP WALK

The CROP Hunger Walk of Franklin County raised \$12,592.50 as of mid November, with a potential for more donations!

One fourth of that money has been directed equally to the Union Food Pantry and the Harvest Table at St. Peter's UCC in Washington.

On the national level, CROP Walks have invested in community-driven development projects in 30 countries worldwide and are making grants to nearly 1600 US based food pantries, food banks and soup kitchens!

As of November 19, CROP Walks have raised \$5,438,235 with more coming in daily!
